- 住 zhu4 is the verb 'to live' or 'reside'. If you look at the components, you'll see that it has the 'ren2' radical on the left. The component on the right is similar to the character 王 which we know means 'king'. But there's a little dash on the top. This dash represents 'a little bit' and a 'little bit of king' is 主 which means 'master'.
- The place where a person is master is the place where they 住


## 在


